### Irving Salsberg AIA

(excerpted from a report in *The Boston Globe*)

Irving Salsberg AIA died at 86 in November. Born in Russia, Salsberg came to the U.S. as a child and his family settled in Chelsea. He attended Boston University and the BAC before earning his architecture degree at MIT. He worked for a variety of firms before starting a firm with Ralph LeBlanc AIA and then later formed his own firm. His work included Cabot Estates in Jamaica Plain, the Faulkner Hospital Nursing School, The North Shore Music Theater, Temple Beth Am in Randolph, and numerous hotels including the Back Bay Hilton, the Logan Airport Hotel, the Friendship Airport Hotel in Baltimore, and The Colonnade Hotel. Salsberg chaired the BSA Urban Design Committee in the 1970s and devoted much of his life to the Boston Architectural Center, which he served in many capacities including a term as president and chairman of the board of directors. Services were held in November.
