

U.S. EPA New England Regional Laboratory



The New England Regional Laboratory in Chelmsford, Massachusetts is a single-story structure with brick exterior that was specifically constructed for the U.S. EPA as their Regional Laboratory for environmental testing. The 67,000 square foot structure incorporates an array of environmental features, including energy efficient heating and cooling systems, active solar power and lighting, recycled materials, environmentally friendly landscaping, improved indoor air quality measures and support for wind-powered electricity to run the building.
