**East Campus/Sloan School of Management project
Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge, MA**

Designed by Buzz Yudell of Moore Ruble Yudell Architects & Planners in collaboration with Sasaki Associates, this multi-phased 450,000 square foot complex will create a vibrant new community for the study of management and economics at MIT. This new home for the Sloan School of Management, Economics department and Dewey Library will include a grassy park overlooking the Charles River that will be ringed by cafes and other social spaces in the surrounding buildings. The project is currently in schematic design.

The East Campus project will be registered with LEED and will seek a Silver or Gold certification. Marc Rosenbaum is the high performance building design consultant and Arup are the MEP engineers. The design process has been customized to learn from MIT's other recent project to create a model process that will result in a truly sustainable, high-performance building. A fully integrated design process analyzed a series of integrated building systems options to develop an energy efficient, cost effective project. First costs and operating costs were combined into a life

cycle cost model, the result of which demonstrated that integrated green design can cost less than conventional design, all in a building that will offer significant improvements in occupant comfort, health and satisfaction.

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
