**Hampshire College, Sustainable Campus Planning**

TK&A has recently completed an 800-acre sustainable campus plan for Hampshire College in Amherst, MA, a year-long process which drew the participation of the entire community through a series of workshops and an interactive website. The resultant plan encompasses a series of initiatives related to campus zoning, facilities planning and construction, landscape improvements, operations, and education.

This plan, developed by William Maclay Architects and TK&A, reflects an incremental, holistic approach aimed at changing daily life as well as institutional decision-making. The plan includes an assessment of existing building and utility profiles and recommendations for campus masterplan building siting, landscape design, and materials selection. Based on recommendations set forth in the plan, the College has restructured its planning, administration, and committee structure to assure greatest attention to matters addressed in the Sustainable Campus Plan. Today, Hampshire is at the forefront of academic leadership in helping to transform what is meant by a "sustainable campus."
