

### **Bargmann Hendrie + Archetype, Inc.**



Bargmann Hendrie + Archetype, Inc. and RES Engineering, Inc. have been retained by the Town of Brookline, Massachusetts to provide design and engineering services funded by an MTC Renewable Energy Trust grant. The Town plans to renovate and upgrade the Stephen Train Memorial Public Health Center, a 3-story building erected in 1953 and comprising 15,500 square feet as a model of sustainability. As such, the project builds on an existing Climate Change Action Plan and other environmental initiatives and energy reduction commitments established by the Town. At the Health Center, efficient heating, cooling and lighting methods are proposed and such renewable energy technologies as solar photovoltaic, fuel cells and wind energy are being considered. Issues related to indoor air quality and indoor environmental comfort are also addressed, and the renovation may feature a new atrium. The study will assist the town in its promotion of green design in local government buildings and is intended to be a resource for planning future municipal facilities.
