The Boston Society of Architect's Women in Design Committee invites women designers to submit work for the exhibition: *Urban Interventions/Built or Unbuilt work by women designing in Boston.*

what

A juried exhibition of design work open to women in the fields of architecture, interior design, interior architecture, engineering, landscape architecture, and urban design. Built or unbuilt projects designed in urban settings within the last 10 years by Boston women designers are eligible. Applicants of all levels are encouraged to apply; however, a woman must have a leading role on the project. The main judging criteria is design excellence.

Winners will be exhibited in the BSA Space as part of a separate curated exhibit of recent women BSA award winners. Included in this exhibit will be: Höweler + Yoon Architecture, KVA ^{mat}, Leers Weinzapfel Associates, SsD, Studio Luz, Maryann Thompson Architects and others. A slideshow of all submissions will also be displayed.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

An electronic file of your submission, project description and registration form are due by 4:00 pm, Monday, April 29, 2013. Late submissions will not be accepted. Email submissions to exhibits@architects.org.

Each submission must include the following:

1. PDF of a 24"x36" horizontally formatted board. Do not list firm or project member names on board.
2. Project description PDF on one page. The project description to include name, firm name or school, contact information, and an explanation of project in fewer than 300 words.
3. Registration Form PDF with payment information.

Winners will be asked to print and mount materials.

Submissions are free for BSA members. Non-members must include \$25 payment to the Boston Society of Architects. Students are not required to pay an entry fee.
