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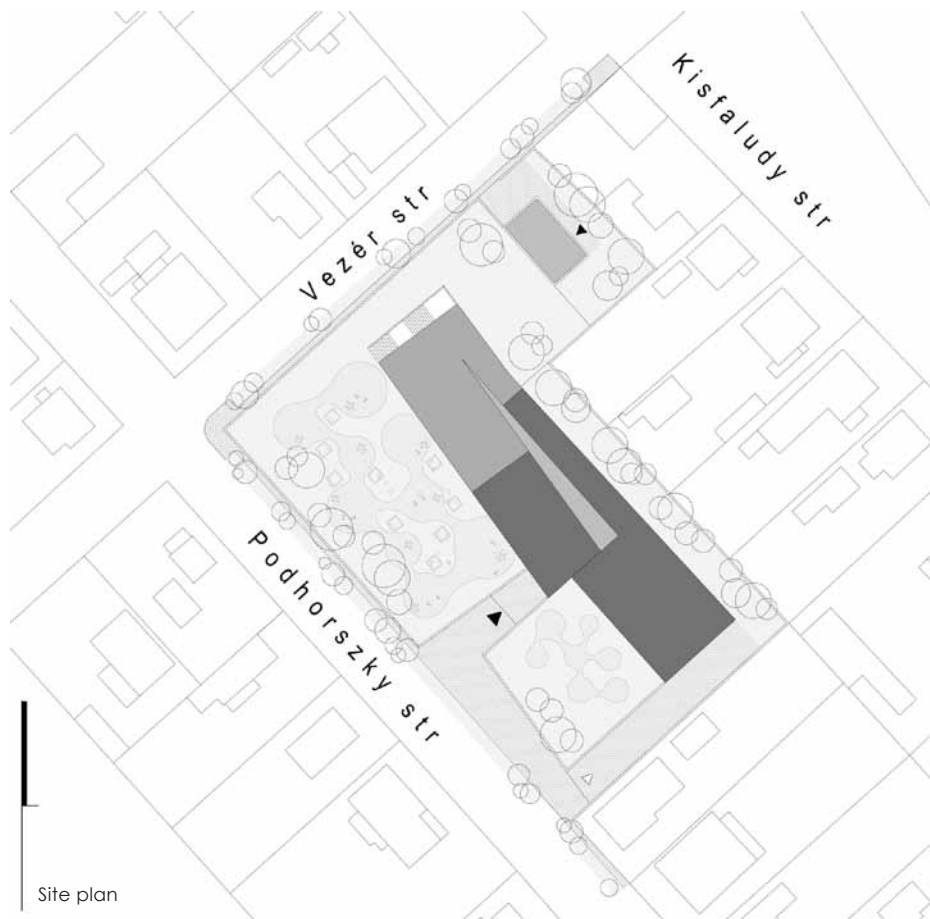

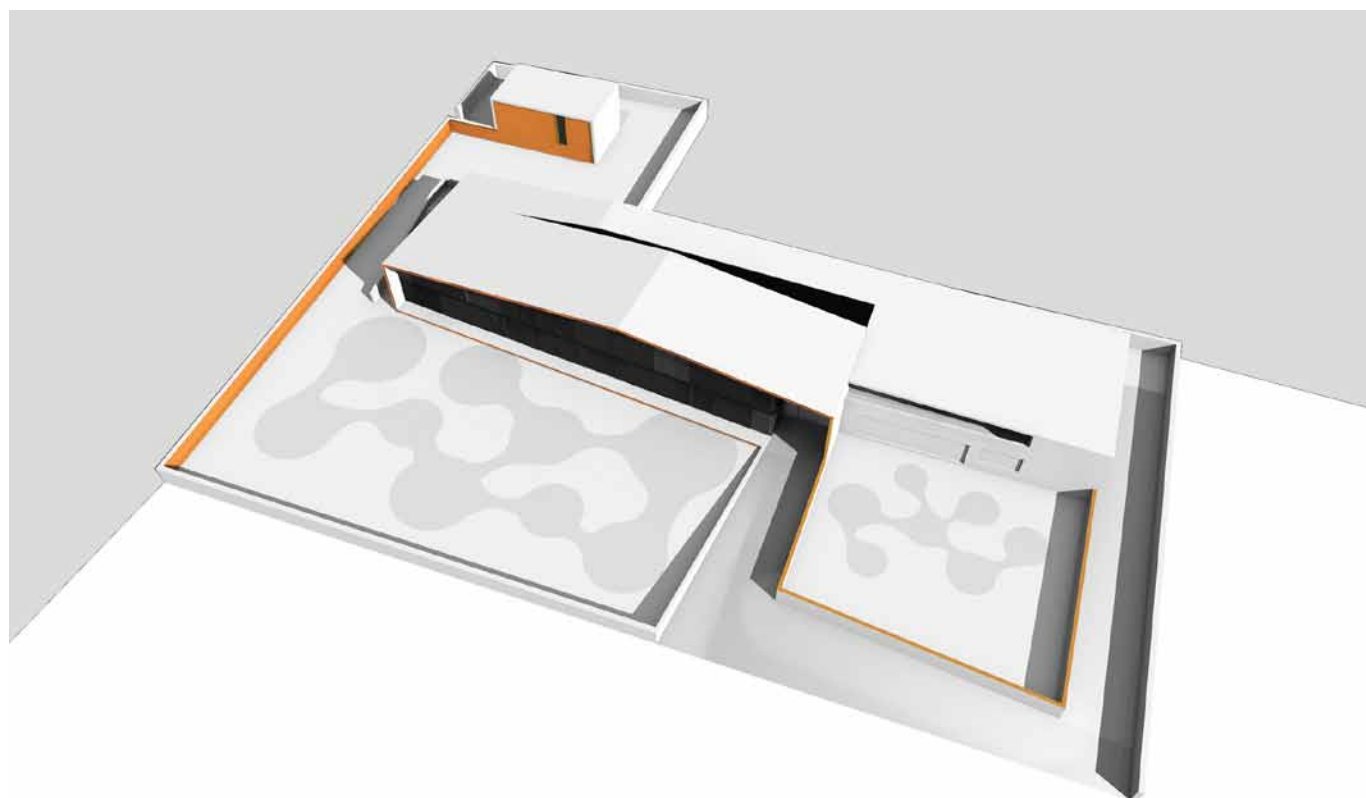


The project is located in a residential area in the suburbs of Budapest. The houses in the neighbourhood were built in the '70-s and they didn't change for the past 30 years.

Our aim was to propose a design that would respond to its existing surroundings while accomodating the needs of the school in a modern characteristic volume.

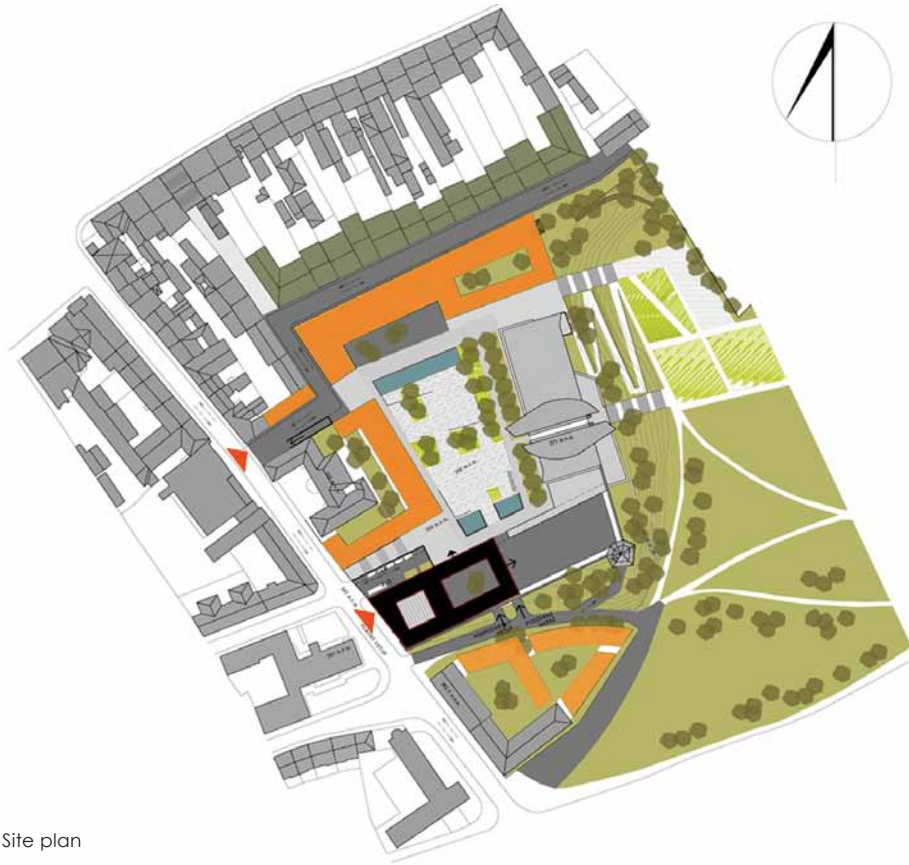
The building itself is a frame, a protective shell, that harbors the children's colorful world. The friendly materials, furniture, toys and drawings create a safe and comfortable atmosphere starting their visual education.

The building opens towards the sun, playground and garden to the south-west. There are 9 playrooms each with private service facilities on two floors. All rooms have outdoor terraces and access to the playground.

Site plan

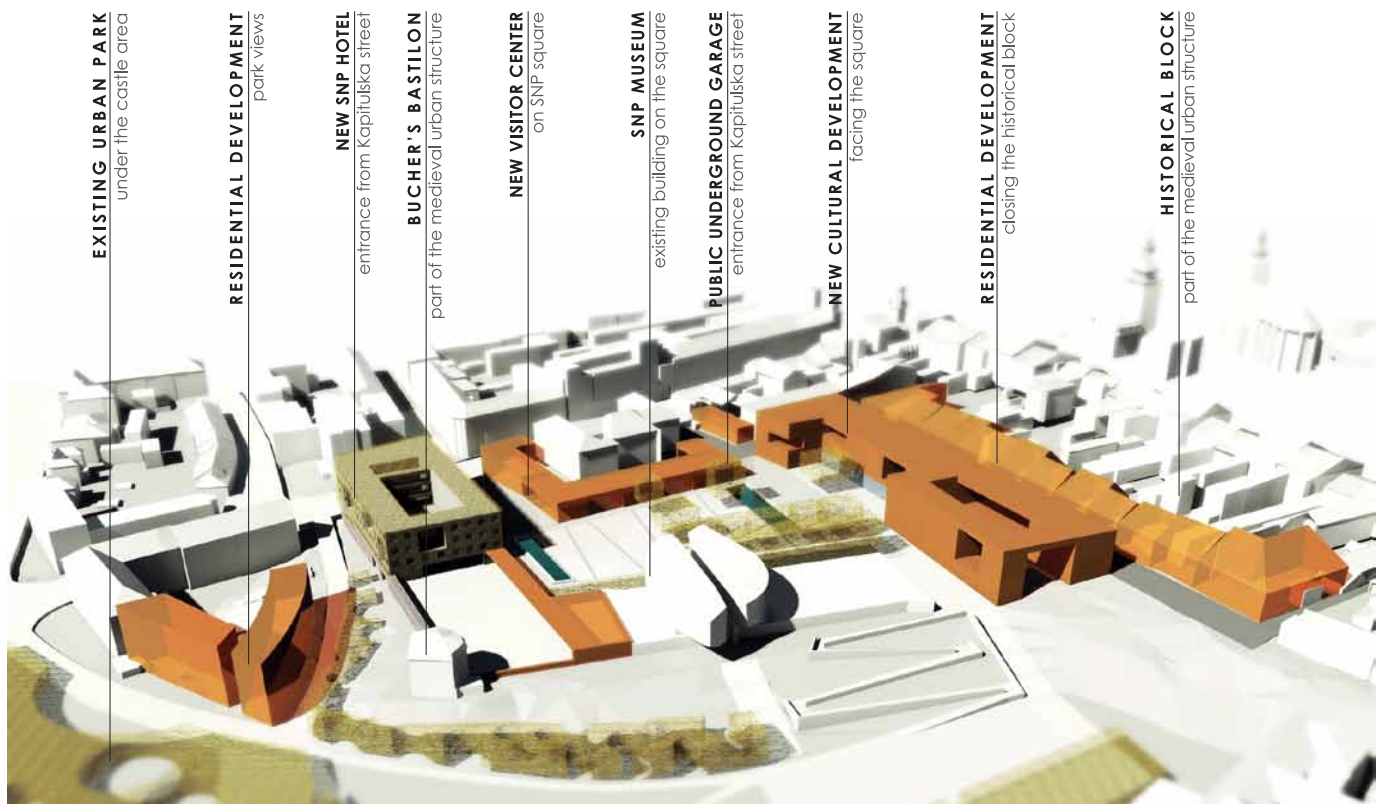


The subject of the competition was an urban-architectural solution of a network hotel in the urban monument reservation of Banska Bystrica Slovakia.

The site is located in the South-West corner of the medieval fortification system, in close proximity to the symbolic building of the Museum of Slovak National Uprising. Today the condition of the site is not pleasant and not acceptable for the historical city center.

Our aim was to revitalize the area, to design an urban square, where open-air events can take place creating cultural atmosphere in urban life.

We wanted to integrate a contemporary building with medieval urban monuments. The entrance of the building opens from Kapitulska Street on the ground floor with a two storey high lobby. The hotel is connected with the square on 1st floor where the conference hall and the restaurant take place.
