Thank you for your interest in joining the AIA and choosing the Boston Society of Architects (BSA) as your local chapter. The next two pages of this document are the application form for Associate AIA membership. This first page explains the dues amounts for 2020.

The AIA is a three tier organization requiring membership in the national, state and local chapter. Local and state dues are combined under one amount for BSA dues.

If you wish to join under the Recent Graduate program please complete the corresponding Recent Graduate application and include a copy of diploma.

If you are currently precipitating in the Architectural Experience Program (AXP) you may be eligible for a waiver of BSA (local/state) dues. Please contact membership@architects.org for the Boston Society of Architects Future Architect Scholarship program.

Dues amounts will be pro-rated for first-time applicants joining during the year as follows: 1st quarter 100%, 2nd quarter (beginning April 1) 75%, **3rd quarter (beginning July 1) 50%**, 4th quarter (beginning October 1) 100% (applicant will receive member benefits through December of the following year).
